General Information

The Academy of Model Aeronautics Headquarters is a 1,200 acre facility, and the MultiGP International Open will be spread out all across the grounds. Due to the size of the venue, planning how you are going to get from field to field is important. Pilots who are driving to the event will have the ability to move about the facility with ease, and parking will be available at each of the fields for the pilots.

PLEASE NOTE!!! VEHICLES OTHER THAN GOLF CARTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ON FLYING FIELDS!

We also recommend that if you have an electric scooter, skateboard, Segway, etc. that you bring it for your navigational ease.

Do not walk on Drone Race Courses or traverse flying sites unless retrieving your craft at the direction of a Track Leader, Race Director or Flightline Director.

Please obey all posted speed limits, give right of way to pedestrians and be respectful of the property.

Registration Area On-Site

When you arrive on site, you should first stop at the registration area. Registration will be in the AMA Museum building on the right hand side when you pull into the AMA facility on Wednesday and Thursday. The remaining days registration will be at the main stage location. Registration is open from 8am to 3pm Wednesday through Saturday.

You can't proceed through inspection unless you have a ticket. Don't have one? Visit <u>multigp.io</u> while you are in line and buy your ticket! The staff at registration will check your ticket and issue your pilot badge. Pilots must have AMA membership card in hand. A pilot must have a **full, current AMA membership**. If you are from another country and you need AMA membership, you can purchase an affiliate membership for \$36/year. The following form must be filled out for an affiliate membership, and may be filled out on site: https://www.modelaircraft.org/files/902.pdf. Canadians aren't required to purchase affiliate memberships if they are MAAC members due to the AMA-MAAC reciprocal agreement.

At the registration table you will be given your badge and lanyard. In addition you may receive a bag with items from our sponsors. The lanyard has a place for your name and QR code for scanning into ZippyQ to que in each track. You may also use the QR code on the Racesync mobile app, or however you have it stored. Your racing group will also be confirmed here and T-Shirt if ordered at the proper time.

At Registration there may be Tech Inspection in addition to Check-in.



On-Site Concessions

On-site concessions will be provided by food vendors selling standard "food-truck" style concessions at the vendor village located at the Mainstage Track. Check out that all time favorite pork tenderloin!

WREKD Recycling-Battery Disposal

WREKD is providing recycling receptacles at EACH IO track for all smashed, trashed and otherwise unusable quad parts! They can recycle everything from props, to arms, to lipos! Look for the WREKD branded recycling bin at each track - OR at the WREKD vendor booth at Main Stage! Bring your dead lipos to the booth and you'll get a ticket to be entered into a PRIZE DRAWING at the end of IO!

Trackside Hospitalities and Charging

Portable restrooms, wash sinks, and complimentary water will be provided at each field at the 2023 MultiGP International Open. There will also be fire extinguishers and basic first aid kits at each field for emergency situations. Power will be provided at every flightline. New this year we have capitalized on "shore power" in most instances, though a handful of tracks will be on a pair of generators where available. There will be at least one power service for the Flight Line and one power service for the Pilot Pits. That said, generators can overheat or stop running due to large loads, so please follow these two protocols:

- A. Power is limited, each line is 15a-30a. Don't overload the line with unnecessary power draw (i.e. fans, multiple power supplies, coffee makers)
- B. Some tracks will have a designated area specifically for the placement of chargers, use these areas if provided.

WREKD Quad Repair Station

IO is all about racing and in racing there is breakage. It's not easy to repair on the tiny Pilot Pit tables, full of quad gear! Stop by the WREKD vendor village booth to take advantage of the portable repair station. This is a complete repair station with power, solder irons, and magnifying glasses for all the over 40 pilots so you can fix your own quad.

Camping

To book your campsite, please visit for the latest availability and rates.

Primitive Camping – No electricity or water \$5 per night for AMA members \$10 for non-members.

RV/Motorhome - No electricity or water \$5 for AMA members \$10 for non-members per night.

RV/Motorhome – With electric hookup \$17 per night for AMA members \$25 for non-members (total number of electric hookup sites 39), stay six nights and seventh night is free. We do have six full-service spots (two are on reserve) at a cost \$20 per night for AMA members, \$35 for non-members, stay six nights and seventh night is free.

An RV dump station is available on site.

Due to Indiana State Board of Health requirements, all campers (primitive & RV) MUST register at one of the above-mentioned locations. If someone arrives after hours, he/she should register first thing the next business day. This will be monitored closely!

Dogs

Dogs must be on a leash at all times. You are also required to clean up areas that your pet uses.

Flying FPV or Line-of-site is only permitted in designated areas. Long-range flights are not allowed (even if within Line-of-sight). Non-racing UAV's, i.e. Phantom's & Mavic's are not permitted unless permission is specifically provided by a Track Leader.

EMT Presence

Rules No Smoking in Tents

No smoking or vaping is allowed under or within 25' of any tent on the property. Please be courteous and refrain from these activities around other patrons, especially minors.

Alcohol, Controlled Substances & Firearms

No open alcohol is allowed in, near or on any track or flying area on the Academy Model Aeronautics property. All IO pilots and guests must obey local container laws and also refrain from using glass bottles. Controlled Substances and Firearms are not permitted on the AMA Headquarters grounds.

Product Sales

Sponsors and entities leasing space in the Vendor area are allowed to sell products. Aside from pilot-to-pilot exchanges for cash, barter or otherwise, directly or through a gear swap, there is to be absolutely no other sales of

product on the property. This policy will be zero tolerance and strictly enforced. Contact <u>sales@MultiGP.com</u> for vendor opportunities.

Pilot Queuing Area, Introducing ZippyQ

The magic of the 2023 MultiGP International Open is the queuing system, ZippyQ. This idea has matured greatly over the years with the help of lead MultiGP Director of Development, Roger Bess, aka Focus. This easy to use system will be used at all the tracks and can even be used at your home field! Visit ZippyQ for more info.

ZippyQ is a tablet system that lets pilots pick their frequency and when they want to fly. It's very easy to use! Find the Kiosk on the track then pick your channel then scan your QR code. The QR code can be found on your lanyard, Racesync Apple App, or on your pilot page at multigp.com. You will then be put in queue for that track. Just keep track of what round is up now and which round you signed up for! ZippyQ will also keep a pack count for pack limited tracks!

If you decide not to fly, please tell the race director so they can remove you from the queue and let other pilots fill that seat! Please follow the antenna polarity noted on each track when you sign up for a channel.

New for 2023, you can now ZippyQ in for 2 flying slots at once!

Qualifying or Fun Flying

Every heat will be logged for each pilot, whether it's "just practice" or a qualifying run. If you know your time is false (i.e. doubled around the start/finish gate practicing), please notify the Track Leader after your heat so that this can be corrected. You should be able to monitor your lap times via the result pages at Livetime and at the local tracks.

Even if the track isn't in your skill set / format, line up and fly!

One Quad per Heat

While Pit Switches are strongly encouraged, every track is technically in qualifying mode and manned by a mix of volunteers. Therefore, each pilot will be allowed to take multiple drones to the launch pads in case their primary selection has boot-up, start-up or arming issues to physically swap out a back-up. However, each pilot may only launch 1 quad per heat.

Radio Settings

To maximize the enjoyment of all the pilots at IO we have some required settings that you should set your radio to. These settings have been tested thoroughly at MGP events such as Mayhem, IO and Champs and known to provide the best compromise of performance, range and interference free flying. If your radio protocol is not listed below, then you do not need to adjust anything as these radios are usually locked at a specific power that works well.

- Crossfire-Crossfire and other 900mHz Control @ 100mW MAX, Forced 150 Hz. You should have a blue LED on the back of your transmitter.
- Ghost- Ghost should be set to TX power of 100mW and the mode should be set to Purerace.
- TBS Tracer- Tracer should be set to 100mW.
- ExpressLRS- Set to 100 mW

VTX Setting and Track Usage.

VTX settings are the most important settings to make IO an amazing event for you and other pilots. Please follow the rules below...or fear the wrath of the hammer! DJI and Walksnail will be allowed at the Freestyle track only. Certain channels may be assigned if a problem is noted on the other tracks. Sharkbyte/HDzero will be allowed at all the tracks. Each track, except the Freestyle track, will have HDzero Event VTX's to record both digital and analog for DVR reviews of flights. All analog and digital VTX's will be set to 25 mW. It is highly recommended to have smart audio/telemetry connected.

- DJI 25mbps and 25mW
- Wlaksnail-25mbs and 25mw
- Sharkbyte/HDZero 25 mW

Competition Rules

Each Track/Competition/Game has its own set of rules that will be either presented in the pilot manual, covered by the MultiGP Rulebook (available here: http://multigp.com), posted at the track, or announced before commencing. Each track is managed/officiated by a Track Leader. Any appeals, requests for reviews, reruns or calls will be under the track leader's authority based on their understanding of the rules and the situation.

The hierarchy of officiating is -> Scoring -> Track Leader -> IO Race Director (Joe Scully) -> MultiGP Commissioner (Chris Thomas). Any appeals will be limited. Keep in mind there is almost unlimited qualifying, and the primary goal is "fun"... the competition will heat up during the Championships, so let the Qualifying remain chill and easy going!

IO Specific Requirements are listed throughout the Pilot Manual. Failure to meet an appropriate spec will result in the craft/pilot being denied flight until the spec is met (i.e. 25mW, OSD, <100mW Crossfire / Other 900mHz Control, etc.).

Any major rule changes or ground rules put in place will be posted at http://MultiGP.io and itemized in the back of this Pilot Manual. Standard MultiGP rules from the 2023 Rules and Regulations apply. This is a "living document".

Start Blocks

Per the 2023 Rules and Regulations, if MultiGP is providing the start blocks, these must be used and unmodified for starts. You may NOT add to the start blocks.


Regulated VTX power output is integral to providing a successful RF environment. If you are unsure about your VTX power output, go to Registration for Verification. Accidents happen, but VTX output power issues can result in multiple accidents per incident. Random Power Testing will also be performed. Do not exceed 25mW, and immediately comply with any direction of any Track Leader if they direct you to fix an issue. Warnings will be limited, if at all.

In addition, any and all registered pilots must adhere to the MultiGP Code of Conduct - https://www.multigp.com/terms-of-use/

MultiGP retains the right to remove any participant or spectator from the property for not adhering to the rules at any time.

Finals/Championships

Each Track/Competition/Game has its own set of rules, presented below.



Most Championships will be a top-16 Bracket unless otherwise stated. Here is the bracket:

When competing in this format, please follow along by listening to the Race Director that will announce something similar to: "BobbyFPV and Clark_Crash go to Race #6, no channel changes, GeorgioLOS and PilotBilly go to Race #5. GeorgioLOS you'll be moving to Raceband 8, same antenna" It is the responsibility of you, your spotter, your coach, your friends or your family members to capture this information. **DO NOT ASK THE RACE DIRECTOR YOUR NEXT HEAT AND CHANNEL!!!** You may follow the heat sheets on the Livetime Page provided at the start of the race by hitting "refresh"... it SHOULD (wifi permitting) show you your next heat/channel. You may ask the Flight Line Director (thumbs up/tablet) or a person they designate for your heat information if you are unable to find it. Do not leave the flightline until you know your next heat, channel and antenna polarity.

Oftentimes, championship brackets will culminate into "Chase the Ace", a format where the final 4/8 pilots race repeatedly until someone wins twice.

Chase the Ace Race Format for Final

The Final 4/8 start with a clean slate, with the winner being the first pilot to earn two Wins (perhaps it is done in 2, but it could go 5/9 races!)

The rest of the podium is decided by their combined finish positions with the lowest total, (i.e. 1, 2, 3 [6] would beat 2, 2, 3 [7]), with the tiebreaker being motocross style - meaning the ranking of the last race determines the ranking (i.e. 2, 2, 2 [6] would beat 1, 2, 3 [6]).

Ironman Clause

If the Top Qualifier wins each of their races through the brackets to the Final 4/8, they will automatically win the event if they win the first race in the Final 4/8.

Even if Chase the Ace is scheduled for a given race, it may be removed by the Track Leader/Race Director if the schedule is running behind.

Ground Stations

This year we will not have pilot ground stations available. We advise pilots to bring both left and right patch and omni antenna and find what works best for you at each track. Pilots are required to follow the polarization of their channel at each track. These alternate around the park, for example R1 may be LHCP on one track and RHCP on another track.

If you see another drone on your channel while you are flying please let the track leader know ASAP. If you're flying a google module and the track leader doesn't see it on the Ground Station, it is your antenna placement, positioning or gain that caused the issue. If it's observable on our Ground Station, we will track down the perpetrator and rectify the situation.

We fly 64 Pilots at once on 8 tracks. How? By following these standards:

- Low VTX Output more power, more problems
- **Constant power monitoring** VTX's transmitting over 25mW interfere with other tracks once they reach 20-30' in the air, so we attempt to catch everyone before they take off
- **Constant Track Video monitoring** Ground Stations connected to a DVR to multiplex all 8 FPV Feeds.
- **Video Aerial Systems Crosshair Antennas** the perfect gain for close proximity FPV Racing (10.25db), and a good beam (120 degrees). The metal on the back of the crosshairs "block" the other tracks
- **HDzero Event VTX's** these units can receive both analog and HDzero transmissions and switch automatically!
- **Antenna Alternating** all of the tracks are back-to-back like a "clock", and alternate polarization based on adjacency, an extra "barrier" between interference from an adjacent track (or tracks)

Goggle Modules WiFi Use

Many of the goggle modules, goggles and radio transmitters now include WI-FI capabilities. These have the potential to interfere with video signals of the pilots in this very congested area. We request that you turn off all Wi-Fi capabilities, including streaming directly from your goggles.

Each track has its own schedule, final or set of championships, scheduled "games" or impromptu "games". Each race has a designated format for the finals, these are subject to change for weather and other considerations.

From 8am-10am the tracks are open for anyone to fly, but are not staffed with timing systems. There are certain nights when all tracks are closed due to main races, and flying is prohibited at these times to ensure RF quality.

6pm is the cut-off of staff and volunteer support for tracks other than the main stage. Most tracks will completely power down during this time and may have obstacles lowered to prevent damage from weather or stray golf carts.



Tracks, Competitions and Group Races

Here is where you find all the details of the events at IO so you can plan your perfect drone racing odyssey. MultiGP continues to try different approaches to the International Open to find that perfect pilot experience. This year we are introducing Group Races, and the "everyone gets a race" concept.

Group Races

Group races include a predetermined group of pilots that do not need to qualify for a race. Each pilot will be assigned a group based on their current 2023 MultiGP GQ data. If you can't get a GQ in before you get to IO, we will have it set up for you to run to get your group assignment! Get those GQ's in, and you won't have to run one at IO before you compete! These groups are, Lipo Fires, High Voltage, Cracked Props, Hammers and Smoked Motors. We anticipate the groups to be 40 pilots in each group.

When the group races are scheduled to start, there is no qualifying or practice, it's RACE TIME! So be at the track 30 minutes early to check in, and we will roll right into 1 of our 2 formats.

Format A: Triple run mains, to a final main

- Pilots are randomly assigned into one of 6 subgroups of up to 8 pilots.
- Each subgroup will race 3 times. The winner of the subgroup will be determined by combined finishing position in the best 2 races. The tie-breaker is the pilot with the best single finishing position (1-2-3, beats a 2-2-2). If there is still a tie, then the best laps/time from the best finishing position run is the final tie breaker
- Subgroup winners will advance to the A-Main event for 3 races, which will follow the same format to determine the winner of this group race.

OR

Format B: Double Elimination bracket:

- This format will only be utilized if there are less than **32 pilots**.
- Pilots will be randomly seeded for the first round.
- After each race, top 4 pilots advance, up 4 bottom pilots move to the losers bracket, or eliminated if it is a losers bracket race.
- Chase the ace final.

The goal is for every pilot to have the opportunity to participate in a racing event (rather than time trials) every day at the MultiGP International Open presented by TBS. There are many different races going with specialty races, group races and World Cup qualifying on 2 tracks so pick your race and enjoy!

1 - Team Black Sheep Presents: Main Stage

The Main Stage will be up on Wednesday Afternoon through Sunday Morning. The main event of the International Open presented by TBS, the World Cup, is hosted here on Saturday night. Throughout the week we will have different specialty races and our Chapter Organizer Appreciation Event.

FAI USA Team Selection

Join us for the chance to be part of the qualifying drone race for the selection of Team USA headed to the FAI international competition in October 2023! This will be an exciting and competitive event, designed to test the skills of the top drone racing pilots in the world. The qualifying race for Team USA will be held on the Main Stage at the MultiGP International Open presented by TBS. The Championship will take place from 6 to 9 October 2023 at the Chunhyangol Stadium in Namwon, Jeollabuk-do, about two hours south of Seoul. It will include prize money of \$100,000!

The race is open to all drone racing pilots who meet the qualifying criteria. The following are the criteria for Team USA:

- Full AMA Membership
- Willing to Travel to Korea Oct 6-9, 2023
- US Citizen

A Maximum of five individual competitors will be selected, providing that at least one competitor is Female and at least one is Junior. A competitor is considered to be a junior up to and including the calendar year in which he/she attains the age of 18.

Note: In addition to the national team classification, every competitor of a national team also competes for the individual classifications (overall and, where appropriate, Junior and Women).

(Alternates will also be selected in the unfortunate event that a pilot is not able to attend.)

We will start with qualifying for both groups, then do the over 40 bracket, followed by the over 50 race.

- Any pilot that is in their 40th year may enter (39 years of age as of Jan 1, 2023)
- Any pilot that is in their 50th year may enter (49 years of age as of Jan 1, 2023). A pilot may compete in both races if they qualify. Age to be verified via Identification at Track Leader's Discretion

World Cup Competition Specifics

The MultiGP International Open presented by TBS is the culmination of the week of racing! Here you will find the top 64 pilots in the world battling for that coveted title of World Cup Champion! Will it be a known 'robot' or is there a newcomer that will make a mark on drone racing with an unexpected upset? All tracks are closed during the Final 64 race, so come on down and get a good seat to watch the excitement on the track narrated by the one and only, the voice of MultiGP, the MC of Drone Racing, Joe Scully .

Requirements

- 800q max weight
- Finished in the Top 64 on the World Cup combined list
- Each quad is required to have at least 2 groups of LED's facing opposite directions to maximize visibility regardless of orientation of the quad. Each group of LEDs must be at least 3 individual LED's. Pilots will be expected to register with their intended color at the start of an event.

Musical Quads

• 4-5 pilots at a time depending on # of participants. Orbit the designated flag/gate until the music stops. Once music stops, all pilots will race to the landing area and land within the landing square. All pilots MUST be within the landing square to be able to continue. Last pilot to land is out. Continue rounds with the winners of previous rounds until 1 pilot remains. Medals will be awarded

Yeet Shooting

• (play on skeet shooting) 3-4 pilots at a time depending on # of participants, popping balloons with their quad.- 4-5 (depending) black balloons will be filled with confetti and then blown up. 4 balloons filled with multi-colored confetti and 1 balloon filled with red confetti. Balloons will be distributed and hung from gates/flags within the course. Pilots will line up on the starting blocks, 3 2 1, Go! Pilots must race to pop a balloon. The pilot that finds the red confetti balloon wins the round. Continue until all pilots have flown, then continue with the winning pilots until there is one final winner. Medals will be awarded.

Qualifying for the Sendit Showdown explained

• A set trick list of possible tricks (20) will be posted and displayed on flyers through the tent as well as a video for visual demonstration will be posted. Pilots will have 2 chances to qualify (thurs-fri), in a 3 min time limit)

with one possible mulligan before the comp (sat) if time allows. Pilots will have to complete at least 10 out of the 20 (pilots choice) tricks in order to qualify to be in the competition. Tricks will vary in skill level from beginner to advanced. Tricks will also be assigned a point value, 1 or 2. (1 point will be awarded for open air tricks and 2 points will be awarded for tricks within obstacles on the track) The day of the competition, we will take the 10 top scoring pilots who qualify to be in the Sendit Showdown.

- Pilots can qualify at any time thurs or fri by contacting Myself (HTD) or my co-host (DanZ) in order to set scores
- Scores will be posted by the end of the day Fri and if pilots wish they can leave a phone # inorder to receive a
 text, contingent on making it to the competition, held Saturday morning.

Sendit Showdown rulings

- Each pilot will be given 2 runs consisting of 2 minute heats, with 3 judges, flying individually. Scores will be taken by 3 judges with a total possibility of 100 points per judge and 300 points in total for a perfect score. Best running score out of the 2 runs will be taken for the possibility of a podium spot. In the case of a tie, each tied podium holder will have a 1 minute heat to advance their position. 1st 2nd and 3rd place trophies awarded
- Judging based on 3 main categories with a total of 11 points possible within each category and 1 bonus category with a total of 1 point to total 100 points overall possible from each individual judge
- 3 main categories are: Consistency, Creativity, and Overall Flow of the run
- Bonus category (Inspired by FPV Livestream SuperCritical!)- JNSQ or je ne sais qua

- Tiny whoop racing will be casual practice every day except the last night after the World Cup race.

- During casual practice you can come up to Jesse P or any of the Tiny Whoop volunteers and ask to do one of your two official qualifying times.
- We'll use those times to pick a top 16 who will enter a double elimination bracket immediately after the world cup, starting at 9:30pm Friday.²
- The last chance to qualify will be Thursday night
