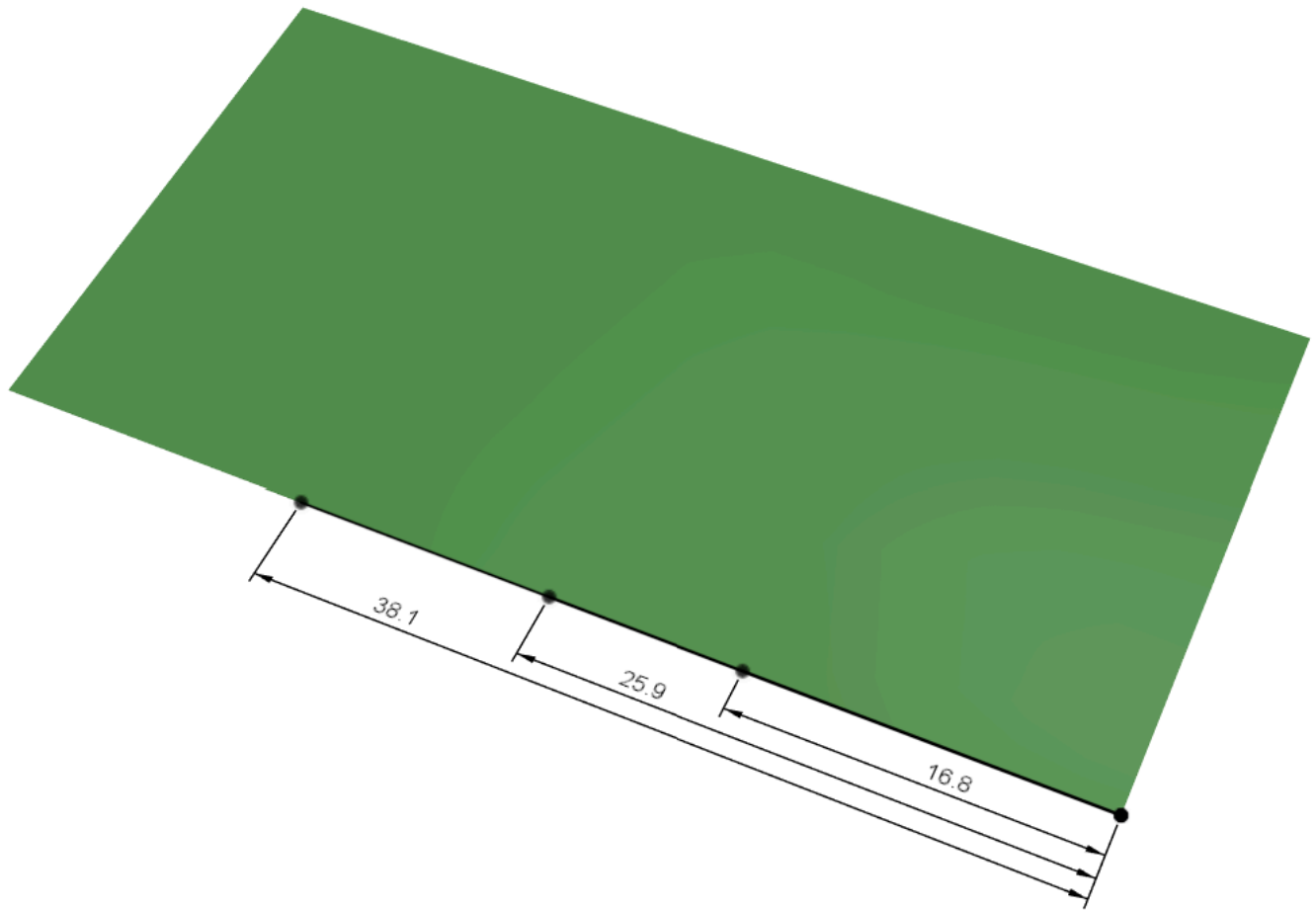


Summer GQ Instructions

Well, you made it to the summer GQ! This one is a little simpler to set up. There is only 1 flag that **MUST** be a stand along flag, please take note of that.

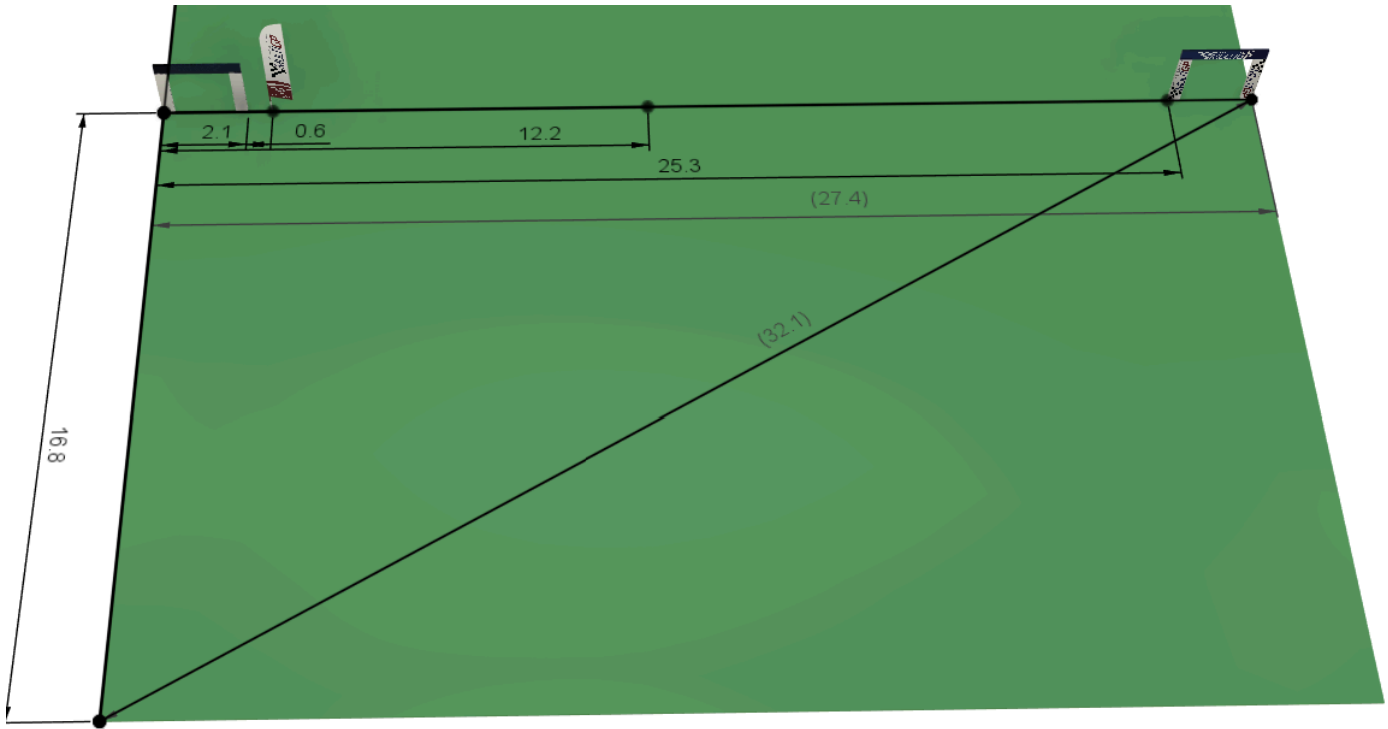
Step 1.

- Lay out the long tap measure 28.1m.
 - Place Gate Rebar at 16.8m
 - Cone at 25.9m
 - Gate Rebar at 38.1m



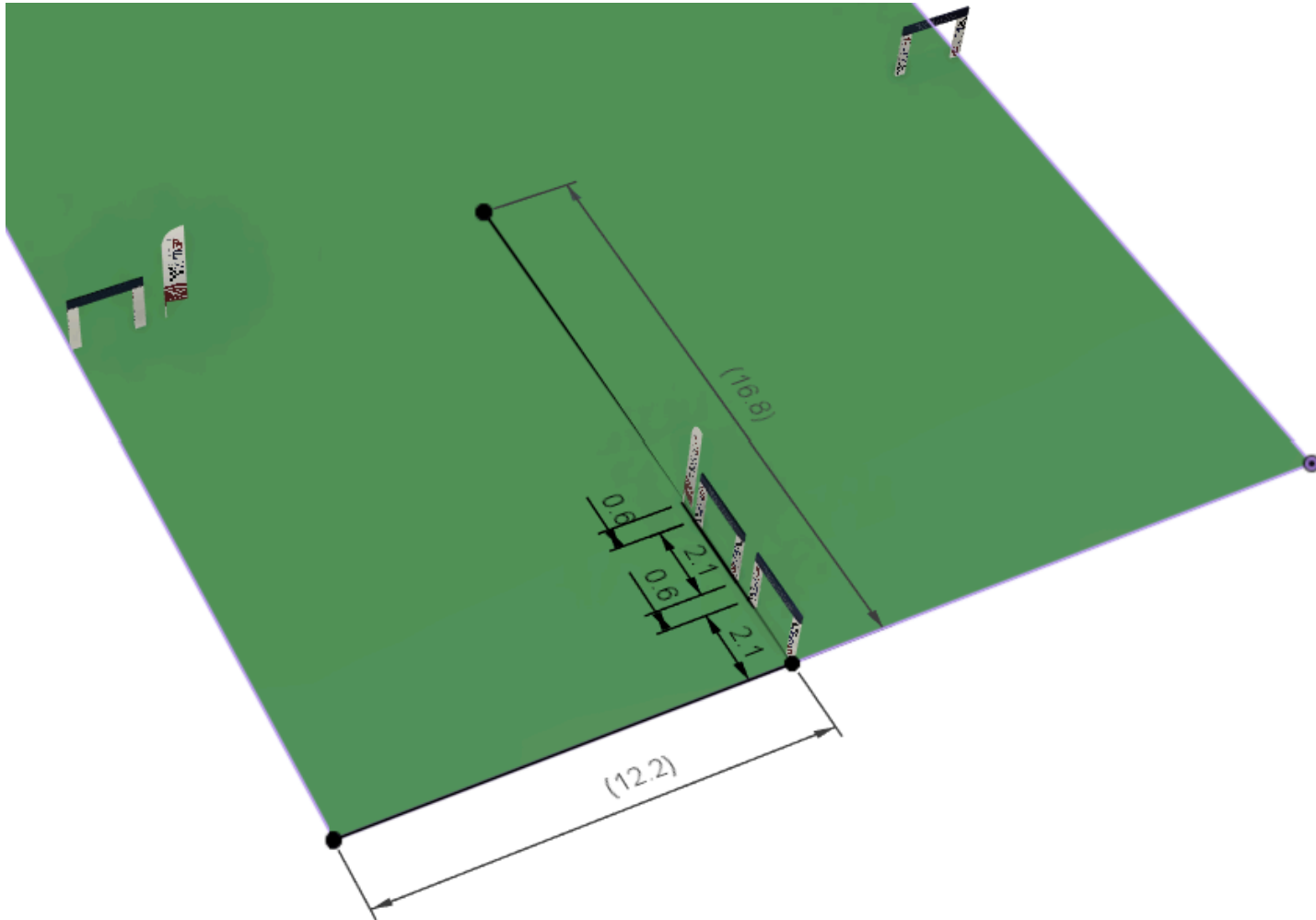
Step 2.

- From the 16.8m Rebar walk 27.4m to meet the 32.1m from the zero
- On the 27.4m line
 - Place a Gate Rebar at 2.1m, 25.3m, 27.4m
 - Place a cone at 12.2m
 - Place a flag at 2.7m. This flag can be free standing, or mounted on the gate your choice



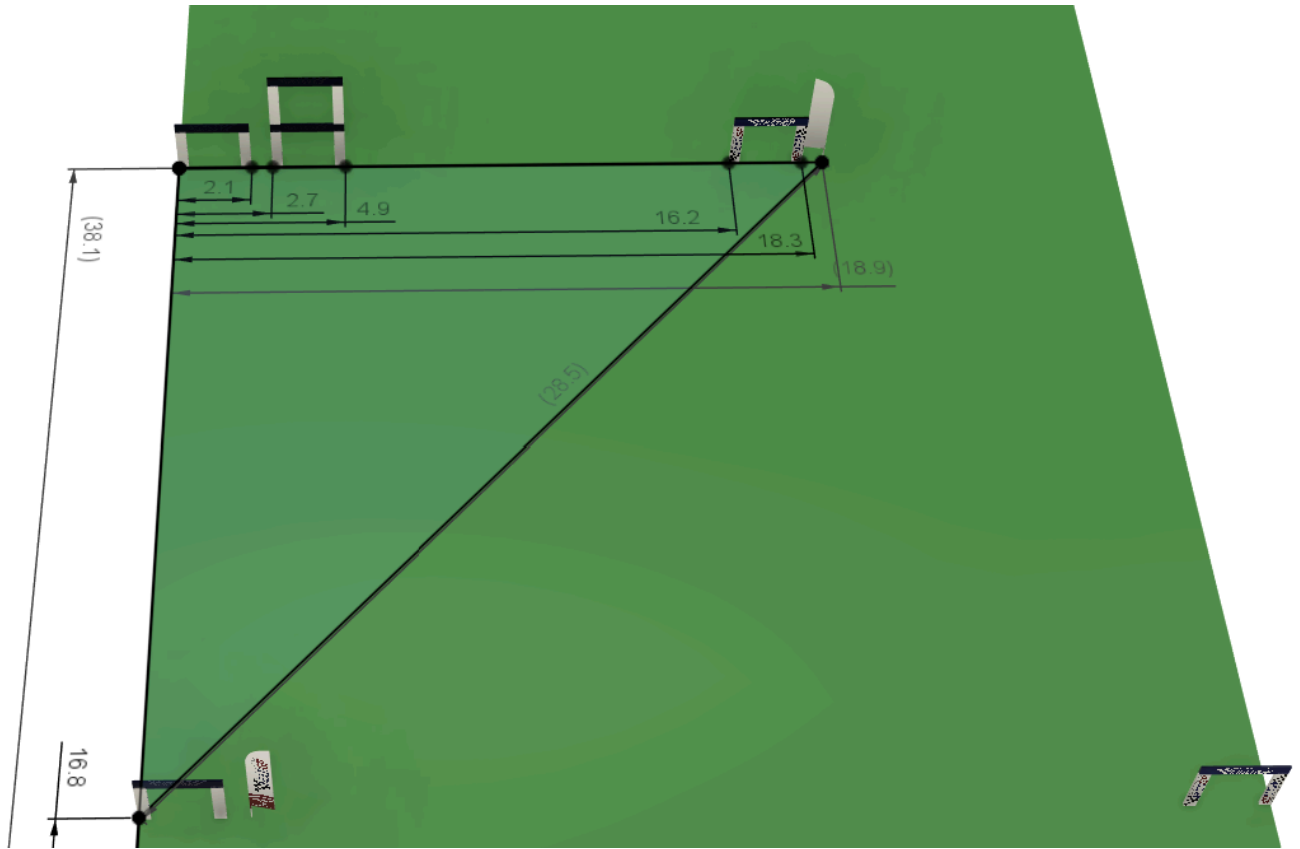
Step 3.

- From the 12.2m cone, walk straight down 16.8m
- From the zero, walk 12.2m to meet, place a gate rebar
- Along the 16.8m line place gate rebar at the following
 - 2.1m
 - 2.7m
 - 4.8m
 - Place a flag at 5.4m, OR mounted on the gate your choice



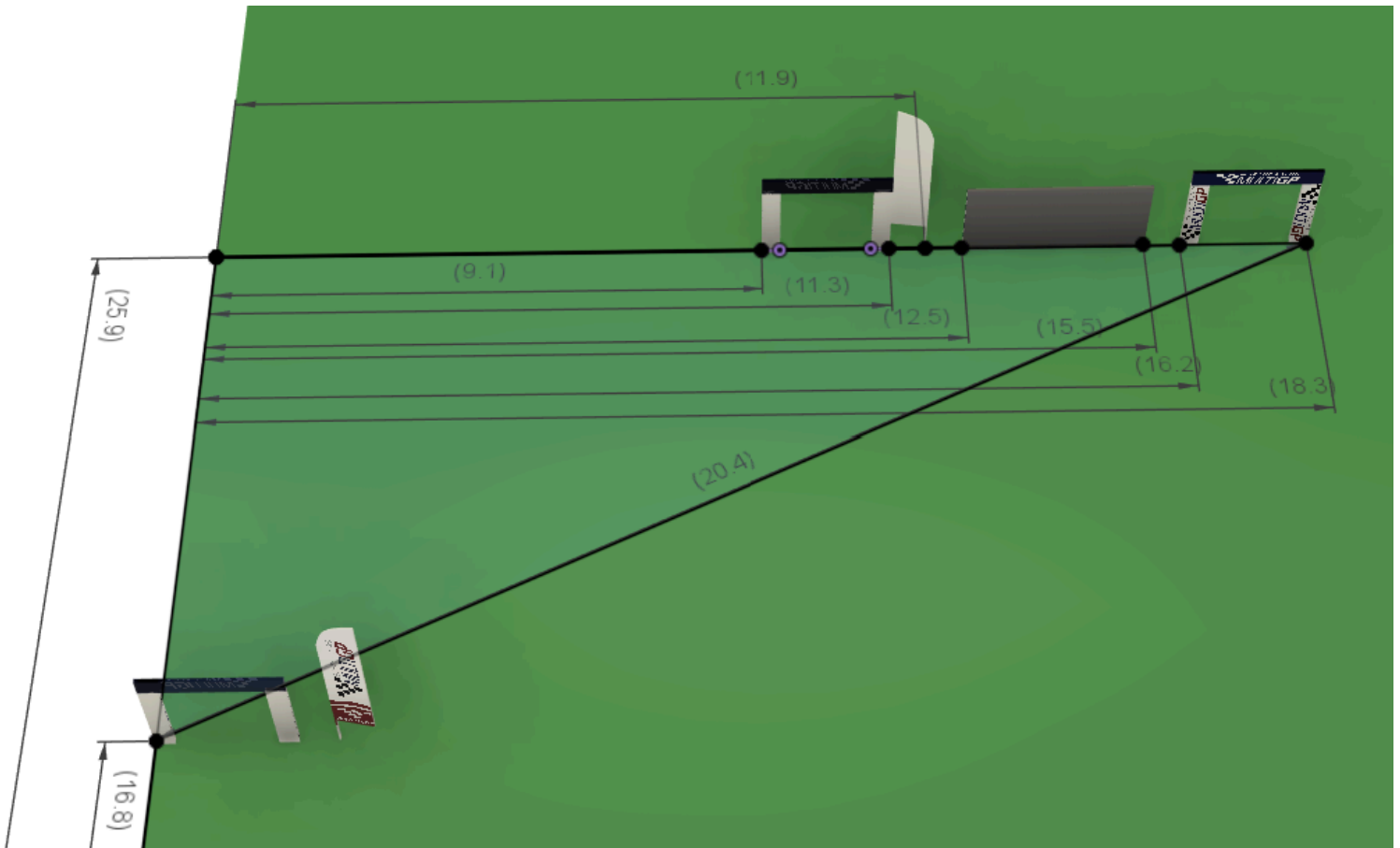
Step 4.

- From the 16.8m gate rebar walk out 28.5m
- From the 38.1m gate rebar walk out 18.9m, place a Gate spike
 - This gate can be stand alone or on a gate, but measuring for consistency
- Along the 18.9m line place the following gate Rebar
 - 2.1m
 - 2.7m
 - 4.9m
 - 16.2m
 - 18.3m



Step 5

- From the 16.8 gate rebar walk out 20.4m
- From the 25.9m cone walk out 18.3m to meet and place a gate rebar.
- Place the following gate Rebar
 - 9.1m
 - 11.3m
 - 12.5m
 - 15.5m
 - 16.2m
- Place a flag spike at 11.9m. This **MUST** be a stand alone flag here. You **CAN NOT** mount the flag on either the hurdle OR the Gate.



Holy Cow Bells that was fun!!! We only have one more flag to do!

Step 6.

- Measure from these two gate leg rebar the distance below. Where they meet, flag stake and flag!
 - 15.9m
 - 11.2m
